I was immediately impressed that Creative Kids calls you the night before camp starts to remind you what you need to bring – your signed waiver form and socks. We also received an email a few days before welcoming us to summer camp and the reminder. Very well planned & great to get a reminder! That was an added bonus for a busy mom!

When you first arrive you must check in & give them your signed waiver form. Your child gets a nametag. They also inform you that you must bring a photo ID to pick up your child – great security! Then Miss Shannon, the owner, directs you to the area your child will go to. Kids are separated by age – a 4-6 year old group and 7-10 group. Some groups go to bounce first, others go to the activities first.

My son got to go to bounce first. Great way to start out – burn off that morning energy! He was greeted by a very friendly Kaitlin who discussed the rules with him by asking him some questions (“Do you know how many kids can go down the slide at once?”) and letting him know the rest of the rules. I thought that was a great way to involve the kids in the rules to make sure they really understand.

After a few hugs and good-byes, he willingly ran off to play. The kids will spend some time in the bounce area getting all their wiggles out. From there they proceed to the arts & crafts, music and activities. The rooms were stocked with puzzles, coloring books, matching and memory games, go fish and more. Kids will also have story time and kid-friendly movies. Special visitors like a traveling petting zoo and magicians will come to delight the kids too! It sounds like so much fun, I wish I was going!

You don't even have to worry about packing a lunch – it's provided by Chik-fil-A or pizza or your child may bring a sack lunch if you prefer.

Children must be potty trained to attend. ALL children MUST WEAR SOCKS so don't forget to bring yours!

When the day was over, my son was very excited and couldn't wait to go back tomorrow – a magician will be there! The kids' artwork was lined up in the lobby – everything from sparkles & glitter to astronauts and suns. The friendly helper, Jill, found his artwork for us. He told me all about his project and his fun day in the car on the way home. He had a super time and your children will too! We highly recommend Creative Kids Camp!

MOMS TIP: Don't forget your license when you get out of the car to stand in line to pick up your child – they will ask to see it. So many of us moms knew we'd need it, but we forgot it anyway & had to make a trip back to the car.
